 the last will & testament of my late Husband Samuel Dinning that may not be
 used in my life time after paying all just debts and giving to each of my
 Arher Children One Dollar I constitute and make and ordain Robert Julian
 my Executors to this my last will and testament with legacies & bequests and
 and every other testament Mills legacies & bequests and

and I do will all and every other testament mills legacies & bequests and
Executors by me in any will before named killed and bequeathed & notifying and
Confirming This and no other to be my last will & Testament in Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of July in the year of our
Lord One thousand Eight Hundred & thirty five
