

In the Name of God Amen, I Anthony Tate of the County of Burgess & State of New York, being sound of Mind & Memory, but Calling to mind the mortality of body and that it is appointed for all men Once to die, do make Constitutions & Ordains this my Last Will & Testament in Manner & form following that is to say, I humbly & Reverently commend my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it and my body I Commit to the Earth to be buried in a decent & Christian like Manner at the discretion of my Executors whom I shall hereafter Nominate & appoint, and as to such worldly goods as it has pleased God to bless me with in this world, I give devise & bequeath the same in Manner & form following, that is to say my devise first & last is that all my Lawful Debts be paid;

Item I give and bequeath to my Wife Margaret Tate all the Property belonging to her at our Marriage and Personal together with two Negroes namely one Philo & Aggy to her, her heirs or assigns forever, Item I further give my Wife Margaret Tate ten bushels of Good Wheat and as many cheap Corn as will feed One horse the ensuing Winter & Summer together with One Man Cell One Cow & Cows and have the herd and all the present crop on the said Plantation between us now live.

Item it is my Will and desire that my Land adjoining David Williams & others containing One Hundred & forty Acres be sold by my Executors to the best advantage.

Item It is my Will & desire that the balance of the Negroes be hired out from year to year until the Orphan Child Polly Tate becomes of age who I am Guardian for, should there not be enough money arising from the sale and hire of the Negroes; It is my Will that Robt. & William be paid and all my Lawful debts be paid, and the balance of them be any to be Equally divided between my two Daughters Viz Sally Tate & Isabella Tate, to them their heirs or assigns forever.

Item I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Sally Tate to her, her heirs or assigns forever, Viz the following Negroes William, Caty Ann, Banks, & Martha their and their increase.

Item I Give & bequeath to my Daughter Isabel Tate the following Negroes Viz Robt, Ann, Viola, Sam and Charles them and their increase to her, her heirs or assigns forever.

Item It is my Will and desire that Esther shall be maintained by my daughter Sally or out of her Estate during her life.

Item It is my Will and desire that Agnes shall be maintained by my Daughter Isabella during her life.

I Ordain that my last Will & Testament in Manner & form following that is
to say & principally I commend my soul into the hands of Almighty God
who gave it and my body I Commit to the Earth to be buried in a
decent & Christian like Manner at the discretion of my Executors whom
I shall hereafter Nominate & appoint, and as to such worldly goods as it has
pleased God to bless me with in this world, I give devise & bequeath the
same in Manner & form following: that is to say my desire first &
last is that all my Lawful Debts be paid;

Wherein I give and bequeath to my Wife Margaret Tate all the Property belonging
to her at our Marriage Real & Personal, together with two Negroes namely
least Phoebe & Aggy to her, her heirs or assigns forever, Also I purchase for
my Wife Margaret Tate ten bushels of Land Wheat and as many cheap
Cows as will feed One horse the ensuing Winter & Summer, together with
One Mare Colt One Cow & Calf, and keep the bees and all the present Crop
on the said Plantation between us now live.

Item it is my Will and desire that my Land adjoining David Witham & John Witham
One Hundred & forty Acres be sold by my Executors to the best advantage.

Item It is my Will & desire that the balance of the Negroes be hired out from
year to year until the Orphan Child Polly Tate becomes of age who
I am Guardian for, should there not be enough money arising from the
sale and hire of the Negroes, It is my Will that Webb & Williams be
paid and all my lawful debts be paid, and the balance of them be
any to be equally divided between my two Daughters viz Sally Tate &
Isabella Tate, to them their heirs or assigns forever.

Item I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Sally Tate to her, her heirs or assigns
forever, viz the following Negroes William, Caty Ann, Wankie, & Martha
them and their increase.

Item I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Isabel Tate the following Negroes viz
Web, Nell, Violet, Vena and Charles them and their increase to her, her
heirs or assigns forever.

Item It is my Will and desire that Isabella shall be maintained by my daughter
Sally or out of her Estate during her life.

Item It is my Will and desire that Agnes shall be maintained by my
Daughter Isabel or out of her Estate during her life.

Lastly I constitute & Ordain my Wife Margaret Tate my Executor & Co-Executor
Tate & John New Executors of this my last Will & Testament, Revoking
and disannulling and voiding all and every other to be Will by me.

with my funeral Expenses Out of my Estate.

I give & bequeath to my Father Timothy McKiver & my Mother Elizabeth McKiver
my Negro Girl Charlotte during their Natural lives, My Negro Girl Thankful I
will to be sold unless my Father Chosen to pay off my Debt out of my Money
or property and in Case he does so he is to have her during his life.

I Will & bequeath to my Brother Peter Monette all that piece or parcel of Land
which I bought from him Containing Eighty Acres More or less.

I Will & bequeath to my Father my Mares & Cows I also Will & bequeath to my Father
my Waggon & Car - I further give & bequeath to my Father all my Stock of Hogs
My will & desire further is that Peter Monette have a Note which I have on him
for the sum of \$1000 - I also give & bequeath to my Father all my other property
