1st I will & devise to my two sons David & Reuben Ingle my tract of land I live on Also a tract of Twenty Acres I bought of my brother Adam adjoining to be divided as follows. Beginning at a stone on the North boundary of my land. Running So. 8th W. to a black Oak in the land then with the land, 2nd 3rd W. to a stone, then with the land, then with the land to the corner & then with said line south through the land. My son David is to have all the land East of said line, & my son Reuben is to have all on the West of said line. I further will unto my Reuben One Horse tract.

2nd I will unto my Daughter Gaby One Horse, Saddle & bridle, Two beds & Furniture, five head of Cattle, such as her sister got when they left me and Otha Household property to make her equal to her sister.

3rd I will and devise unto my beloved wife my Negro boy Peter during her Natural life, & after her death, he is to be sold & equally divided among my Daughters as hereafter stated. I also will her my dwelling house & the use of all my Out house, during her life, & I will that my son maintain her, then Mother & Offord unto her sons, Nibany that will under her life Comfortable, in her old age, as becometh sons to their Mother. I also will unto my Wife One Horse tract, two cows & calves, & two beds & furniture, two pots & One Traying pan, & five Shups & all my Quaker vessels. And the remainder of my property, I will & devise to be equally divided among all my daughters, that part which my daughter Sally Maugh, shall be entitled to I will to her children, by deducting from such part Ninety three Dollars which Money I paid for her husband to Swantz, & I further will that all the property I have willed to my wife, after her death, shall be equally divided among my daughters, & such part as shall fall to my daughter Sally I will to her children, to them & their heirs forever.

And I constitute David Ingle & Jacob Worick Executors of this my last Will & Testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 29th day of May 1827.
