my land, running So. 8<sup>th</sup> W. Twenty Nine Chs to a Black Oak in the land,  
then south the land, & 3<sup>rd</sup> W. Eighteen Chs to a stone, then west Two Chs. & half  
to Ferris Corner, & then with said line south through the land, My son David  
is to have all the land East of said line, & my son Reuben is to have all  
on the West of said line, I further will unto my son Reuben One Horse, best.  
2<sup>nd</sup> I will unto my daughter Galy One Horse, Saddle & bridle, Two beds &  
furniture, five head of Cattle, such as her sister got when they left me  
and Otha household property to make her equal to her sister.  
3<sup>rd</sup> I will and devise unto my beloved wife My Negro boy Peter during her  
Natural life, & after her death, he is to be sold & equally divided among  
my daughter as hereafter shall, I also will her my dwelling house, &  
the use of all my Out houses, during her life, & I will that my son maintain  
her, that Mother & Offord unto her worn, Miskany that will tender her life  
comfortable, in her old age, as becometh sons to their Mother, I also will  
unto my wife One Horse, best, two cows & calves, two beds & furniture, two pots  
& One Tying pan, & five Shaps & all my Quills & pots. - And the remainder  
of my property, I will & devise to be equally divided among all my daug-  
hters, that part which my daughter Sally Alcock, shall be entitled to  
I will to her children, by deducting from such part Ninety three Dollars,  
which money I paid for her husband to Awaunt, & I further will that  
all the property I have willed to my wife, after her death, shall be equally  
divided among my daughter, & that part as shall fall to my daughter  
Sally, I will to her children, to them & their heirs forever.  
And I constitute David Ingle & Jacob Wrench Executors of this my  
last Will & Testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my  
hand & seal this 29<sup>th</sup> day of May 1827
