Whereas I Benjamin Binstow of the County of Guilford and State of North
Carolina, being weakly of body, but of a sound Mind & perfect Memory
think but to make something by way of last will & Testament—
And first I will that all my last debts & funeral Charges be paid and
Discharged by my Executor herein After named.

2^d I will & Ordain that my son Benjamin Binstow have all my
Land & farm whereon I now live supposed to be One hundred & eighty
four Acres More or less as his property forever, by his rendering
unto his Mother a sufficient Support Great or less during her
Widowhood out of the profits arising from said farm.

3^d I will that My beloved wife Lydia Binstow have the possession
of the house & the use of the household & Kitchen furniture of every
kind during her widowhood but if she should Marry my
will is that my household & Kitchen furniture Except my
Clock be equally divided between her and my two Daughters
Elizabeth and Ann Shaw and Shaw alike.

4th I will that my wife have my bag Iron Cane Chain and forty Dollars in Money to be lived and raised out of my Estate to be wholly at her disposal

5th I will that my son Benjamin Bentow have the Clock as his property at my decease

6th I will the remaining part of my property not before disposed of be equally divided, by selling or other wise, between my three sons namely John Bentow David Bentow & Benjamin Bentow share and share alike.

And Lastly I nominate, constitute and appoint my two sons David & Benjamin Bentow. Executors to this my last Will & Testament, revoking all other Wills by me made, Ratifying & Confirming this to be the only in force. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this Twenty sixth day of the past Month 1829.
