sound Mind & disposing Memory thank be to God for the same At this thirtieth
day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred & thirty
two do Make & Declare this my Last Will & Testament in Manner as follows
That I give and bequeath to my two Daughters Anne & Rebecca & Willy all
my Household & household furniture to be equally divided between them when
they come of age by two Men chosen by my Executors
That I will that all my other Estate be sold and the Money be paid out to among
all my Daughters comes of age and there to be equally divided between them
my two Daughters

I further appoint my Father James Miller Executor of this my Last Will &
Testament - he Witness whereof I have set my hand & seal the day
