

I, Border whole of the County of Guilford & State of North Carolina,
being of sound mind & memory, but considering the uncertainty of my
earthly existence, do make and declare this my last will, in manner
and form following, that is to say.

First, That my Executor (herein after named) shall provide for my body
a decent burial and pay all funeral expenses, together with my just debts,
out of the moneys that may first come into his hands as a part or parcel
of my estate.

Then, I give and devise to my beloved Wife Olivia, a part of the tract
of land I now live on bounded as follows: Beginning at the South West
corner thereof, South with St. Hope line until it intersect with the line run-
ning by the house, thence along the line by the house to a Persimmon at
the corner of my meadow, thence of the said meadow to a Stake, thence west
across the meadow to a Stake, thence up the branch until it intersect the
line from the first Station, thence along said line to the beginning to have
and to hold during her natural life or widow hood.

The balance of my land to be equally divided among all my Children.

Then, I give to my Wife one bed and furniture, I give to my wife two
barrels of Corn, four bushels of wheat and two hundred pounds of Bacon,

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Now, I give to my wife all bed and furniture, I give to my wife two
bunches of Corn, four bushels of wheat and two hundred pounds of Bacon,
one wheel and Cattle and horse and for each child my wife Eliza Hooper
two bunches of Corn & 50th of Bacon. All the residue of my estate to be
sold, and equally divided between my wife and all my children, share and
share alike, without bringing in consideration any advancements to any.

Am lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint my truly friends Arthur
Hosler and Eliza Hoskins, my lawful Executors to ~~do~~ all intents & purposes
to execute this my last will and testament, according to the true intent
and meaning of the same, and every part and clause thereof; hereby re-
citing and declaring utterly void, all other wills and testaments by me
heretofore made.

In witness whereof I the said Borden White, do hereunto set my
hand and seal this the first month 11th 1847.
