 And in the manner Directed

Item I bequeath to the children of my first wife Elizabeth the sum of one hundred
 Dollars or the value of money there be the County of Carroll State of
 Tennessee my wife and my Executors have after named as directed by
 Oath as how to be done and what shall be done through the care of a trustee
 for the benefit the way the sum of one hundred Dollars to be paid to the
 through the trust in such manner as to divide the whole trust of the
 them and any into the equal shares or parts which are to be appropriated
 or divided amongst such of my legatees as are to be named as by last
 provided that should any of them for whom it is intended shall be
 And the first part of said trust shall come to a division by selling the
 same it shall be allowed for the same to be retained as has been the last as
 provided and in favor to give the same up to be divided into
 his share as said selling &c.

Item My Executors are to sell with full and complete power to sell and
 convey hold and vend of absolute title in fee simple to such of my
 legal estate or property as they may have to do with of or which they
 for a valuable consideration and disposed and not conveyed by me
 And they are hereby directed to sell at public or private sale as may be
 -t conform with the intent of these provisions and as said Court
 as to them may seem best and that in such things provided shall be good
 and valid

Item I hereby execute and release from all bills bonds notes charges demands
 & accounts whatsoever and from the payment of the same what may
 appear to be due to me or to the late or former of John Murray and
 his Executors from my daughter Polly Murray or from either of my sons
 Alfred or James or John or David

Item I My beloved daughter Polly Murray in addition to what I have before
 now bequeathed to her I give & devise unto her by will
 the sum of one hundred Dollars in addition to what I have given before

them the four children being by my late daughter Aggy Robert Wandy
Willy Brantly James & Robert Mary Brantly & some personally chosen
by the authority of the late Robert Com Said Property then to be Equally
Divided Amongst them.

Lastly I do hereby appoint my beloved son Charles Wandy my second
Nephew & my beloved Grandson William Wandy Executor of the
Will of the said late Robert Com Said Property of all the things therein
Comprised I have set my hand & Seal the 13th day of June 1800
