transience and uncertainty of human life have thought fit to make this my last will & Testament.
My Soul I recommend unto the hands of Almighty God hoping for forgiveness of all my sins only
in and through the merits of my dear Redeemer Jesus Christ - And to what worldly estate
the Good Pleased God to bless me with I dispose of as follows:

First - I give to John Norton one tract of land lying in Spotsylvania County
in the Common Wealth of Virginia, containing by estimation two hundred & forty eight
acres be the same more or less to him his heirs & assigns forever.

Item - I give & bequeath to my son Peter Curtis four hundred acres

Then I give & bequeath to my two grand sons George Morris & John Morris two hundred & forty acres adjoining to the above land I give to my son John Morris & his heirs & assigns forever.

Then I give & bequeath to my dearly beloved wife Margaret Curtis one negro fellow named Isaac to her & her heirs & assigns forever, & in case she should depart this life without disposing of the above sd negro Isaac, my will & desire is that he should be equally divided between my two daughters Mary Johnson & Judy Morris, to whom their heirs & assigns forever.

Then I give & bequeath to my said wife after my just debts is paid all the remainder part of my estate both real or personal to her & her heirs & assigns forever.

Then I give & bequeath to my other children - one shilling each to them their heirs and assigns forever.

Lastly I appoint my said wife Margaret Curtis Executor and George Johnson Executor of this my last will & Testament revoking all former wills by me made.
