Secondly. I give unto my true Heir & Heirs all One Dollar - Thirdly. It is my Will that all of my wearing apparel be equally divided among my Aged Friends. Phoe Coffin Rhoda Turling Paul Coffin Ann Gardner Sally Darggus & Lydia Allen.

Fourthly. It is my Will that all of the Residue of my Estate be Sold and the amount thereof be equally divided among the above named Phoe Coffin Rhoda Turling Paul Coffin Ann Gardner Sally Darggus & Lydia Allen.

Fifthly. I Constitute and appoint my Aged Friends Fickens as Coffin & Samuel Darggus Executors jointly to this my last Will and Testament - In Witness Whereof I have set hereunto with my hand and seal this thirtieth day of the Eighth Month in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred & Twenty Six - Signed sealed pronounced & declared by the Said Christina Rachel to be her last Will and Testament in the presence of

There being in Frederick Coffin one of the Executors appointed in said Will & qualified also Entered into bond in the sum of \$300 with John Shanty security.

I, James & Abner Barnard of the County of Kingsford & State of South Carolina Make Witness that all men must: die being of sound mind and memory. We make & Ordain this my last. Will & Testament: That is to say.

First I Recommend my Soul to God that give it & my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner & as to my worldly substance I Dispose off in the following manner It is my will that all my last. Will. & Testamental expenses be payed off in due time

2^d I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Eunice Barnard the Land I now live on with two cows and one horse such as she shall choose with all the Hogs Sheep & household furniture with both the farming utensils as long as she remains my Widow. It is my will that my house in law Asa and Coffie shall live on the plantation with my Widow. I have her bequest as long as she lives single at the death or marriage of my Widow. my will is that my plantation I now live on to be Equally Divided between my Daughter Mary Parnon & my son Elehu Barnard I give to my Daughter Mary the looking glass that was her mothers I give my beloved wife my Stage Waggon — I give to my Beloved Wife Eunice Barnard all the property she brought with her into my family to her & at her disposal forever —

I give my son John one share in the Cape Fear Navigation to him & his heirs forever. he is a married man & I send —

I give my son Gerson one share in the Cape Fear Navigation if he dies without issue it is to go to my son Ruben I give him one Ox and furniture to him & his heirs forever I have given him land —

I give my son Elehu one share in the Cape Fear Navigation I give my son Ruben one half of a tract of land lying on the Water of Ocharaw that I bought of

First. I Recommend my Soul to God that your A. & my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner & as to my worldly substance I dispoſed off in the following manner it is my will that all my debts. & Personal expenses be payed off in due time

2nd I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Eunice Barnard the Land I now live on with two acres and one third such as she shall choose with all the Hogs Sheds & house hold furniture with both the farming implements as long as she remains my Widow. it is my will that my brother in law Asa Coffin shall live on the place & take care of my Widow & her support as long as she lives single at the death or marriage of my Widow my will is that my plantation I now live on to be Equally divided between my daughter Mary Parsons & my son Elehu Barnard I give to my daughter Mary the looking glass that was her mothers I give my beloved wife my Stage Waggon — I give to my beloved wife Eunice Barnard all the property she brought with her into my family to her & at her disposal forever.

I give my son John one share in the Cape Fear Navigation to him & his heirs forever he is a married man & I am —

I give my son Gorton one share in the Cape Fear Navigation of his share without issue it is to go to my son Rubin I give him one Rod and frontiers to him & his heirs forever I have given him land —

I give my son Elehu one share in the Cape Fear Navigation I give my son Rubin one half of a tract of land lying on the Western of Guilford that I bought of Meaganah May to be Equally divided by & between the three heirs I give him to have & hold

With all my Reluctance I do Love I Bear a witness that
 all the remaining part of my estate I give & bequeath
 To all my Children to be equally divided between them
 I know & thus have given
 My Will is if any dispute should arise either for the
 want of Words or form of Words or any other Cause
 the Court may fully shall such dispute should a man
 of they cannot agree for the word so chosen to be
 one word after their Judgements to be found
 And lastly I Constitute & appoint my Son in Law James
 Ramsay & my Son the Reverend & my Son Elisha Ramsay
 Executors of this my last Will & Testament Ratifying
 & allowing whatsoever they may lawfully do or cause
 to be done & Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my
 Hand & affixed my Seal this fourth day of
 The fifth month One Thousand Eight Hundred
 & Thirty Eight
