Third I Give & bequeath to my Son Edmund About One fourth of the Land where Ruben Benson's daughter live to be laid off by my Executor by running a line North across the Tract he to have the East End

Fourth I Give & bequeath to my son Daniel about One fourth part of the same Land ~~to be laid off by the Executor~~ ^{as shall} be laid off by the Executor next to & Adjoining Edmund's.

Fifth I Give & bequeath to my daughter Nancy about One fourth part of the same Land to include the House & Spring to be laid off by the Executor next to & adjoining Daniel.

Sixth I Give & bequeath to my daughter Millean the remaining fourth the west end of said Tract.

Seventh I leave four Barrows One Sow & seven Shoats to be fattened out of the present Crop to my Executor to settle & manage my business & if there come to more than enough to divide the balance between my said daughters if there is not then to take & sell the Stock until there is. Lastly I Appoint Stephen G. Mendenhall my Executor to this my last Will & Testament. Who is hereby Authorized to Rec^d as much as will be a reasonable compensation for his trouble. 25th 8 Mo. 1825.
