I Daniel Daugherty of the county of Guilford being sick & weak in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given to God calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and testament, that is to say - Principally and first of all I give & recommend my soul to the hand of Allmighty God that gave it - and my Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life I give, devise and dispose of the same in the following manner & form.

First - I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth my dearly beloved wife a maintenance of the estate & her room in the house during her life.
I give to my well beloved sons William and Daniel Daugherty whom I hereby constitute, make & ordain the sole Executors of this my last will & Testament all and singular my lands, messuages and Tenements by them freely to be possessed & enjoyed, and I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke & disannul all and every other former wills.

I further give & bequeath to my wife & daughter Hannah to be equally divided all the cows except two which I give to Daniel & William one each.
I give to my son John Daugherty the sum of eight pounds to be paid out of my real & personal estate - the Leers, Bullock hogs I give & allow for the use of the house - the big cart I give to Daniel & William & the remainder of the

 out of my real & personal estate the Leers, Bullock hogs I give & allow for the use
 of the house the big pot I give to Daniel & William & the remainder of the
 household furniture I give to my wife & daughter Hannah the count of the
 wool must I give to Daniel & the sorrel mare I give to Hannah & the
 black horse I give to my wife the other horses being the property of
 Daniel & William I give & bequeath unto my son James Laugherty

I am now writing testifying his whole legacy to repairs of the house & foundation
I allow to be paid out of the real & personal estate - I do hereby revoke
and disavow all and every other former testaments, wills, Legacies & bequests
validating this - certifying this & no other to be my last will & testament.

twenty eight day of August A.D. one thousand seven hundred & eighty six.
