I Daniel Fisher of the county of Guilford and State of North Carolina first
weak and indisposed in body but of a sound and disposing mind and memory
make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following.

First I will that all the just debts that I shall owe to any person or
persons at the time of my decease be well and truly paid and discharged without convenient
delay out of my estate and goods.

Then - I give unto my son Holliston Fisher one hundred acres of land out
of that tract I bought of Levin Wright at the South end running so as to include
Holliston - provided he takes into his possession my son John and my daughter
Mary and brings them up with such learning as is hereafter mentioned - that is
I give my son John to read, write and cipher as far as the rule of three
(and)

and my daughter Sarah to read and write also I give into the hands of my son
Mollastone one cow and one fether head to be delivered to my daughter Sarah when
she arrives to the age of eighteen or seventeen pounds ten shillings in cash in like time
and also to my said son Mollastone is to give unto my son John one horse and saddle worth
thirty pounds at the discretion of my humble named Executors.

Item I give unto my son Jonathan Fisher the tract of land where I now
live with all the appurtenances thereto belonging likewise all my personal estate of
what name or nature not herein otherwise disposed of provided he the said Jonathan
Fisher takes into possession my three sons Daniel, Theodoris, and Nathan Fisher and brings
them up with such learning as hereafter mentioned that is to learn them to read write
and sign so far as the best of them and when they come to the age of twenty one to give
them each one horse and saddle worth thirty pounds also to give Daniel and
Theodoris each one cow worth five pounds also he is to take into possession my two
daughters Mary and Hannah Fisher and bring them up with learning them to read and
write and when they arrive to the age of eighteen to give each of them a fether head
and cow worth seventeen pounds also my daughter Mary is to have all my wife's
wearing apparel gown and saddle.

Item I give unto my son Thomas Fisher fifty acres of that land that I
bought of Levin Wright at the North end of said tract running so as to leave the
the buildings in my son Mollastone's tract as above mentioned - also the colt that my
brother Mary is now with foal with provided it lives and does well if not he is to
have a horse worth twenty five pounds and some more learning to sign so far as
the rest of them.

And if ~~any~~ either of my children die without lawfull issue my will is
that his or her share of the estate be divided equally among the survivors of my children.

and Abraham Standley Executors jointly of this my last will and testament.
