Daniel March of Guilford County, County, State of North Carolina being very sick & weak in perfect mind & memory thanks be unto God, do hereby make the validity of my body & mind for all men one to do, see, hear & believe to be my last Will & Testament, That when I am dead I will that all my worldly and my Soul into the hand of Almighty God that God live my body I recommend to be buried in a decent Christian burial as the decent manner is, nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the strength power of God. And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life I have devised & dispose of the same in the following manner for use.

First I have bequeathed to my beloved wife Elizabeth One hundred acres of ~~land~~ my land Choice some tract of land Choice Horses or more one Cow & all my bees & in them one room with furniture One lot or duck pond & in it furniture One large Bible One interlaken One large dish & silver plates Six Shoon One Christ two pair of Horse gear one hickory and all the meat on hand now in possession & all the Corn & Wheat & Flax & Cotton also my daughter Charity shall have five hundred ~~on my~~ my wife's hundred acres of land with all her property during her life time without any interruption & support during said time the same as my wife this shall be her right and fifty Dollars to be raised & levied out of my estate for the good and services done unto me for value received her - And all that is over & above with all the land & other property is to be sold at public auction in order to discharge & pay all my last debts & then the balance that is over and above shall lawfully be divided among all my children except Jose & Polly each of them shall have five Dollars to be raised & levied out of my estate for the use of schooling them -

I likewise constitute & appoint John Christman & Elizabeth Smith my wife to be my lawful Executors of this my last Will & Testament all singular & I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannull all & every other former Testaments Wills legacies & bequests by me in any way before named written & bequeathed ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 3^d day of June in the year of

I Thomas Woodburn of the State of North Carolina County of Guilford being in a sound State of ~~health~~ body but of a feeble sound & disposing mind do make & publish this my last Will & Testament in manner of form as follows: 1st After the payment of all my just debts I Give & bequeath to my son John Woodburn One dollar as his full portion of my property. 2nd I Give & bequeath to the heirs of my son William Woodburn One dollar as their full portion. 3rd I Give & bequeath unto my son David Woodburn One Dollar as his full portion. 4th I Give & bequeath to the heirs of my son Arthur Woodburn One Dollar as their full portion. 5th I Give & bequeath to my daughter Mary Wharton One dollar as her full portion. 6th I Give & bequeath to the heirs of my daughter Ann Cornett One Dollar as their full portion. 7th I Give & bequeath to the children of my son Robert Woodburn the whole tract or parcel of land wherein I now live viz to Mary Woodburn Ann Woodburn Margera Woodburn Sarah Cookins Woodburn & Jesse Dickins Woodburn to be divided amongst them share & share alike & my son Robert Woodburn to have his living off it his life time & from rent, also my whole set of Smiths tools. I Give & bequeath to my Grand son Jesse Swain Woodburn & my son Robert to have the use of them to work on his lifetime & from rent, & the remaining part of my probate not before mentioned I leave to my son Robert's children to be disposed
