In the name of God amen David Harrell of the State of North Carolina & County of Guilford being of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be god almighty to me and the mortality of my body knowing that it is ap[s]toned for all men to die I do this second day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & twenty four do make and publish this my last will & testament in manner following that is to say in the first place I recommend my soul to god who gave it and my body to be buried in a decent manner First I give & bequeath unto my well beloved Brother Harvey Harrell One Hundred acres of Land which lies on the East side of the Bay road adjoining the lands of Thomas Hoff & others to be his at my debt to leave & to enjoy full and free possession for ever I also leave all of the rest of my property to be sold and the money that arises from the sale paid what money is now due me after the debts of David to be equally divided among all of the rest of my well beloved Brothers & sisters by them freely to be possessed & enjoyed for ever Attest Made & ordain my dearest friends Robert & Rankin John Daugherty Executors of this my last will & testament In witness whereof I the said David Harrell have to this my last will & testament set my hand I seal the day & year above written
