 Next I Give & Bequeath unto my Well beloved Brother Harvey Herald
 One Hundred Acres of Land which I own on the East side of the Long
 Road adjoining the Lands of Thomas Webb & others to be his at my Will &c
 save & to enjoy full and free possession for ever I also leave all of the
 rest of my property to be sold and the money that arises from the
 sale with that money is now due me after the debts is paid to be
 equally divided among all of the rest of my Well beloved Brothers &
 Sisters by them truly to be possessed & enjoyed for ever & I hereby
 make & ordain my worthy friends Robert W. Rankin & John Haugbort
 Executors of this my Last Will & Testament in witness whereof I the said
 David Herald have to this my Last Will & Testament set my hand
 & seal the day & year above written
