 the Saddle & Spinning Wheel also One Side Saddle On the Value  
 of the Same I also Give to my wife as much of the Crop & Stock  
 as will be Sufficient for One year maintenance After my Death  
 the above Mentioned Articles all Except the Land to be sold at my  
 Wifes Pleasure or at the Expiration of her Widowhood By my Executors  
 And the Money By them Divided Among my three Youngest Children  
 Namely Cummins Nelson & Rahama, I also Give to my wife One  
 Cow & Calf to be Disposed of in the Same manner as the above Mention-

Ninth, I Give & bequeath to my youngest Daughter Rhama  
May be My Negro boy named ~~Robert~~ & a bed & furniture  
fourth choice & in case a Negro Boy should be Refused  
my Daughter Rhama comes to be of age then she is  
to have Three Hundred Dollars in Cash I also Give my

One cow & half otherwise the 10 Three Hundred Dollars to be  
Equally Divided by my Executors among my children  
Sinth. I Will that my Negro Boy namedsted at my Deced  
be paid out yearly by my Executors till my youngest child  
comes of age and the money be then appropriated to the use  
of the family & Schooling my children. Thus I do Negro to work  
Two years and so for my two Boys.

Eleventh I will also that my two boys Cammence & William Maybin  
be the amount of the estate agreeable to the Will admit that it  
is there be sufficient to settle us comfortable without it that they  
have between them one piece of Land being on the south side  
of Crumbers near the River

Twelfth I will that the Remains part of me in both personal  
& Real Estate & Other property not before mentioned in my  
Will be sold at my Deced by my Executors & the overplus  
of the money after selling with the Legals agreeable to the Will  
by my Executors to be Equally Divided among my Children  
And do hereby make and Ordain my worthy friends Robert  
Maybin my Executors of this my Last Will & Testament  
In Witness whereof I the said David Maybin have to this my last will signed  
my hand & seal the day year above Written signed sealed  
and publicly declared by the said David Maybin as his last  
Will and Testament in the presence of us who were present at  
the time of signing sealing thereof.
