do make this my last Will and Testament as follows.

First My Will is that all my estate both real and personal should be sold by my
executors at public sale in such order as they may judge best and out of the proceeds
thereof to pay all my last debts and funeral charges.

2^d To pay over to the heirs of my daughter Elizabeth Harvey the sum of twenty five
dollars.

3^d To pay over to my son William Saunders the sum of Ten dollars or to his heirs.

4th To pay over to my daughter Sarah Shattuck the sum of twenty five dollars.

5th To pay over to my daughter Martha Elliott the sum of fifteen dollars.

6th To pay over to my daughter Jane Day the sum of twenty five dollars.

7th To pay over to my son David B. Saunders or his heirs the sum of twenty five dollars.

8th To pay over the remainder paying all just and reasonable expenses in the management
of my estate in seven equal shares to my children to wit. Elizabeth, William,
Sarah, Martha Jane, Elizabeth and David B. My eldest son Samuel (died) and
my son Jacob having had their portions of my estate.

All payments to be made in current money. I hereby appoint my friends W.
S. Mendenhall and Clara Elliott Executors to this my last will and Testament.
Witness my hand and seal this 12th of 7th Month 1845.
