In the name of God amen - I Edward Tatam of the County of Guilford in the State of North Carolina do ordain and declare this instrument to be my last will and testament, revoking all others.

First - I do give and devise unto my beloved wife Susannah Tatam, during her natural life, all my personal estate, together with my negro slaves, Lusk, Beck and Deen; at her decease to be appropriated to the payment of the several legacies after devised, the residue to be equally divided among all my children, or their heirs.

Item - In addition to what I have heretofore bestowed on my beloved daughter Susannah Tatam, I do give and devise unto him seventy dollars current money of the United States, together with one new pewter dish & half a dozen plates.

Item - I give and devise unto my beloved son Simon Tatam his heirs and assigns the plantation and improvements, whereon John Pyatt formerly dwelt, and all that part of the tract of land purchased from his heirs, which lies situate on the upper side of Pyatts branch, together with forty dollars money of the United States and one new pewter dish & half a dozen plates.

Item - I give and devise unto my beloved son Edward Tatam his heirs and assigns all my lands lying situate betwixt the lands of Stoubert Tatam that now devised to Simon Tatam, together with forty dollars current money of the United States and one new pewter dish & six plates.

Item - I give and devise unto my beloved son Henry Tatam his heirs and assigns all the plantation and tract of land situate on the lower side of the

Provision- all my first debts, are to be punctually paid - finally

Item- I have unto my beloved wife Hickory Tatum, during her natural life, all my personal estate, together with my negro slaves, Truck, Beek and land at her decease to be appropriated to the payment of the several legacies after devised, the residue to be equally divided among all my children, as then born.

Item- In addition to what I have heretofore bestowed on my beloved Herbert Tatum, I give and devise unto him seventy dollars current money of the United States, together with one new pewter dish & half a dozen plates.

Item- I give and devise unto my beloved son John Tatum his part and assigns the plantation and improvements, whereon John Pyatt formerly dwelt, and all that part of the tract of land purchased from his heirs, also lies situate on the upper side of Pyatts branch, together with forty dollars money of the United States and one new pewter dish & half a dozen plates.

Item- I give and devise unto my beloved son Edward Tatum his part and assigns all my lands lying situate betwixt the lands of Herbert Tatum, that now devised to John Tatum, together with forty dollars current money of the United States and one new pewter dish & six plates.

Item- I give and devise unto my beloved son Henry Tatum his part and assigns all the plantation and tract of land, whereon I now reside, together with one new pewter dish one basin and half a dozen plates.

Item- I give and devise unto my beloved daughter Patsy Tatum in addition to what I have heretofore bestowed on her twenty five dollars current money of the United States.

Lastly- I constitute and appoint my dearly beloved wife Hickory

and my beloved sons Herbert Saturn and Simon Saturn, Executors
of this last will and testament.
