Elizabeth Hershey have what remains thereof And let my wife have full
privilege of living in my dwelling house during her widowhood
Also her maintenance

Now I Give & bequeath unto my two sons Stephen & William Hershey all
that piece of Land which I Bought of William Beale to be equally
in value divided between them at the direction of my Executors to be their
heirs or assigns forever Now it is my will that my said two sons
Stephen & William Should pay each of them Twenty five Dollars to my Executors
in Order to help to pay my Debts — Now I Give & bequeath unto my four
sons Enoch Jesse Eliazer & Moses Hershey all that piece of Land which I
Bought to be Equally (in value) divided among them at the direction
of my Executors to be theirs, heirs or assigns forever — It is my will that
Eliazer my son should have the dwelling house when his mother has done with it

Now I Give & bequeath unto my son Enoch that mare which has been called
his but if she has a Colt let his Brother Eliazer have the first she brings

Now I Give & bequeath unto my two sons Jesse & Enoch each of them a Colt
which has been called their's.

Now I Give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Hershey One Tea table Bed
& Furniture One desk And One large Picture desk.

Now I Give & bequeath unto my two daughters Alice Buson & Esther Holfington
To Each of them five Shillings Sterling

And lastly I nominate and Appoint my truly Brother in law Stephen Hartline
& my Wife Elizabeth Hershey & my son Stephen Hershey Executors of this my last will
& Testament hereby making void all former Will or Wills by me heretofore made
or appearing in my name declaring allowing & Confirming their said no other to be

& Furniture One desk And One large Puch desk.

Now I Give & bequeath unto my two daughters Alice Buson & Esther Wolfington
To each of them five Shillings Sterling

And lastly I nominate and Appoint my Truly Brother in law Stephen Hartline
& my Wife Elizabeth Harsy & my son Stephen Harsy Executors of this my last will
& Testament hereby making void all former Will or Wills by me heretofore made
or appearing in my name declaring allowing & Confirming their said no Oble to be

North Carolina & County of Guilford (Farmer) being very sick &
weak in body but in perfect mind & memory Thanks be given unto God
Calling unto mind the mortality of my Body & knowing that it is
appointed, for all men Once to die. Do make & ordain this my
Last Will & Testament that is to say principally first
of all I Give Recommend my Soul into the hand of Almighty God,
that Gave it, & my Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in
decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors, nothing
doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the
same again by the Mighty power of God. And as touching
such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in
this life. I Give devise & dispose of the same in the following
manner, to wit. Also I Give & Bequeath to my well beloved
Wife Elizabeth Miner the following Articles To wit That is to say
all the real & personal during her life or widowhood, except
such as shall be mentioned hereafter. Three of the Choice head
of Cattle, one horse best choice and as many Hogs as will be
sufficient to fatten for one year. Provisions & as many to Chow
fowls as will hereafter support. And three head of Choice of the
Swine and all the Balance of the Stock to be sold to gether with
Other Articles One Side & Coffers and the Balance of Wheat
