January the 18th 1795. - I Elisha Flack of Guilford County in
the name of the Holy and Evergical God do make and constitute this my last will
and testament in manner and form as follows viz:

Item - My will and desire is that my brother Elijah Flack should take

special care and maintain and grant to my mother all privileges on the place that I now live during her life and consideration of the above mentioned articles truly performed by the above said Elijah Black also that he Elijah Black shall give to my sister Boreas Black the value of eighteen pounds.

Item - I give unto my brother Elijah Black for the above consideration ten hundred and sixty acre of land on the lower part of my land.

Item - I give to my sister Hannah Black one Gray horse one p. & 1/2 hwt.

Item - I give to my brother Andrew Black one hundred and fifty acre of land at the upper part of my land lying along the North and South line adjoining Sals Hutton.

Item - I give to my brother Thomas Black my saddle and wearing apparel.

My will and desire is that my brother James Black should be my sole Executor of this my last will and Testament.
