for and in consideration of her diligent and affectionate conduct to me and
my wife

I give devise and bequeath to my sister Sally Mendenhall the boat of mine which I
purchased of Henry Mitchell lying in Randolph County & appraised to
contain one hundred dollars to have and to hold the same to her and her
heirs

I hereby appoint Andrew Lindsay of Guilford County one of my Executors
in addition to the appointment of my wife heretofore made, and it
is my will & desire that he should qualify as such with my wife
I give and bequeath to Jonathan Parker

I do give to my wife Susannah Mendenhall all my lands Tenements & Hereditaments
to hold to herself and her heirs for ever

I bequeath to my wife Susannah Mendenhall all my personal Estate of Every
Description to hold to herself, her Executors Administrators & Assigns

to wit, I give and bequeath to my friend Maria Hilda three one thousand
Dollars in money to be paid at the expiration of twelve months after my decease
for and in consideration of diligent and affectionate conduct to me and
my wife

I give devise and bequeath to my sister Betsey Ward the tract of land which I
purchased of Henry Mitchell lying in Randolph County supposed to
contain one hundred Acres, to have and to hold the same to her and her
heirs

I hereby appoint Andrew Lindsay of Guilford County one of my Executors
in addition to the appointment of my wife heretofore made and it
is my will ~~that~~ ^{desire} that he should qualify as such with my wife
I give and bequeath to Jonathan Parker for and in consideration of his
kindness and services rendered me the sum of Five Hundred Dollars
to be paid in money within twelve months after my decease

I hereby revoke all former Wills and Codicils by me heretofore made except the one hereto attached of which this is a part. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 17th day of February A.D. 1836.

In the name of God Amen. I, Robert Mendenhall of the County of Guilford and State of North Carolina do make this my last will and Testament

1st I give and devise to my beloved wife Martha Mendenhall my House and lots lying in the town of Greensboro. with all the improvements thereon of what ever nature. including the lot and dwelling I now live. I also give and devise to my said wife Martha Mendenhall Two tracts of land lying near the town of Greensboro. containing one hundred and thirty acres one purchased by me from Wm. D. Shields and the other the part of a tract purchased from Eli Stranland all the above real Estate to give and enure to my wife Martha and her heirs for ever.

2nd I give & devise to my wife Martha during her natural life my interest (it being one third) in the mill and tract of land lying in charge
