Eight Hundred & thirty, Make & publish this my last Will & Testament
in manner following that is to say.
First I Give and bequeath to my son Joseph Harrell ten Bunches of Corn &
ten bushels of Wheat & three hundred pounds of Pork, for him to possess
enjoy, & receive all the Claims I have against him as Guardian, and all
other Claims
Second I Give & bequeath to my Daughter Abigail Phipps three bunches of Corn
five bushels of Wheat & two hundred pounds of Pork to possess
Third I Give & bequeath to my son Henry Harrell the sum of Two Dollars to possess
Fourth It is my Will & desire that after paying all my Just debts the remaining
part of all my property be equally divided amongst all my surviving
Children my son Henry Harrell excepted.
And I hereby make and Ordain my two sons James H. & Joseph Harrell
Executors to this my last Will & Testament & give them full power
to settle all my estate and the Estate of my husband David Harrell dec.

and affixed my seal to this my last Will & Testament the day of

Whereas I James Micks of Guilford County and State of North Carolina, knowing the
great uncertainty of life and the certainty of death being at this time provided
with my Common Mind & Memory, do make this instrument of Writing as
a last Will & Testament for a Guide for my Executors hereafter to be appointed
to dispose of my Property that I may leave in this world at my death.
Now I say Will is that my beloved Wife shall have her maintenance of the land
and plantation where I now live.

Item 2. My Will also is that the said land where I now live supposed to be One
Hundred & fifty Acres, I will & bequeath to my son William Micks, meaning
that he shall maintain his Mother which she remains my Widow, or in
Other words that the said land & plantation shall support her out of the
profits thereof. I also will & bequeath to my son William Micks my Clock
and Chest of Drawers.

My Will and desire is that all the remainder part of my Estate be sold, my
dearing apparel excepted) and the Money Arising or proceeds of the same be
Equally divided among all my Children that is to say, Peter Micks, William
Micks, James Hodson, Ruth Hodson, Deborah Hodson, & Rachel Marmont,
and my wearing apparel be divided between my two sons Peter & William
as they may think proper.

I also do appoint my sons Peter Micks & William Micks my whole & sole Executors of
this my last Will & Testament to which I have hereunto set my hand & seal
this Twelfth day of 11th Mo. in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred
& Twenty Two.
