resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power
of God as touching such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God
to bestow me with in this life I have desired and disposed of in the
following manner and form viz.

I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Sarah One hundred
and twenty five acres of Land including the plantation I now live
occupy with all appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any way
pertaining to the same by her freely to be possessed and enjoyed
During her natural life and at her decease I will leave & bequeath
the same to my well beloved son called Brown and his heirs and
assigns forever upon this condition that he shall & truly pay to my
executors here after named the sum of forty Dollars to be equally divided
amongst my other slaves according to the true memory and intent
of this my Last Will and Testament.

I also give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Sarah One house
from among my stock of which I desire her to have the right
of choice and which ever she may chose I give and bequeath to her
During her natural life together with all the farming utensils
also two feather beds and furniture and as much other house
and kitchen furniture as she may think proper to retain in
her hands and possession during her natural life with one
years provision for her and all stock that she may choose to
hold possession of for my will and memory is that she shall
have two cows her choice among my cattle and two hogs
as she may think proper to have

I give to the heirs of my well beloved daughter Mary Lumpkin
the sum of fifty dollars to be raised and saved out of my
estate

also her feather beds and furniture and as much other house
and kitchen furniture as she may think proper to retain in
Her hands and possession during her natural life with one
years provision for her and all stock that she may choose to
hold possession of for my will and meaning is that she shall
have two cows her choice among my cattle and her back hog
as she may think proper to choose

I give to the heirs of my well beloved daughter Mary Simpson
the sum of fifty dollars to be raised and laid out of my
estate

I also give to the heirs of my well beloved daughter Elizabeth
by debtors the sum of fifty dollars to be raised in
like manner

I also Give and Bequeath to my daughter Sarah Delworth the sum of fifty Dollars to be raised in like manner.

I also give to my daughter Martha Delworth the sum of ten Shillings to be raised in like manner.

I also Give and Bequeath to my will beloved grandson Abram Delworth the sum of Ten dollars and fifty cents to be raised and paid out of my Estate to be paid to him by my Executor when he shall arrive at the age of Twenty One Years.

I also Give and Bequeath to each of my three Grand Daughters the sum of Fifty and Four Shillings and Sixpence Dollars and Sixpence to be Raised and paid in the same manner as my Will and Testimony is that if any of the above mentioned four Grand Children should die before they arrive at the age of Twenty one Years that my executors pay to them Remaining the sum left to the deceased and my Will and Testimony is that all just debts or claims on my Estate be punctually paid and satisfied by my Executors out of my estate for which purpose I will order & Ordain that they as soon after my Death as convenient make publick Sale of all my Goods and Chattels and moveable effects otherwise than what I have already disposed of together with a certain tract or part of Land lying in the aforesaid County of Bradford I intend to contain about Twenty one acres to be the same men or ^{if} ~~if~~ and also Give and Bequeath to each of my three will beloved daughters Joseph Cycwall Elyah likewise the sum of ten Shillings to be paid in like manner.

And I further Will and Ordain that after sale be made as above directed of the above named moveable effects with Land &c that if there be any thing remaining in amount of sale after the above bequeathed all my just debts to be satisfied that the Balance be equally divided and distributed amongst my heirs above named.

And I do hereby nominate Constitute appoint and Ordain my well beloved son Elyah Shew and Abraham Puffer the sole Executors of this my Last Will and Testament and I do hereby attorney unto them all and do allow all other Mells legatees and Bequeathers in any class before named Nilled or Bequeathed ratifying and Confirming this and no Other to be my Last Will and Testament this 11th April 1821. Legally sealed publickly pronounced and signed in the presence of ^{as his} John P. Darrow his Last Will & Testament

I also Give and Bequeath to my well beloved Grandson Abram
Beloveth the sum of Ten dollars and fifty cents to be paid and
Lived out of my Estate to be paid to him by my Executor when he
shall arrive at the age of Twenty one years.

I also Give and Bequeath to each of my three Grand Daughters viz
Jane Murray and Ann Beloveth the sum of Six dollars and
Eighty cents to be Paid and paid in the same manner now my
Will and Meaning is that if any of the above mentioned four Grand
Children should die before they arrive at the age of Twenty one years
that my executors pay to them Remaining the sum left to the Dead
and my Will and Meaning is that all just debts or claims on my
Estate be punctually paid and satisfied by my executors out of my
estate for which purpose I will order & Ordain that they as soon after
my decease as convenient make publick sale of all my Goods and
Chattels and moveable effects otherwise than that I have already
Designed of together with a certain tract or part of Land lying in
the aforesaid county of Gadsden I command to contain about
Twenty one acres to be the same more or less and also Give and
Bequeath to each of my three well beloved daughters Joseph Egbeal
Elijah Murray the sum of six Shillings to be paid immediately after
And I further Will and Ordain that after sale be made as above de-
scribed of the above named moveable effects with Land &c that if there
is any thing remaining in amount of sale after the above beque-
aths all my just debts to be satisfied that the Balance be equally
Divided and distributed amongst my heirs above named.

And I do hereby nominate Constitute appoint and Ordain my
well beloved son Elijah Murray and Abraham Pugh the sole Exec-
utors of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly
revoke all annall and do allow all other Wills signatures and Bequests
in any wise before named Willed or bequeathed ratifying and
Confirming this and no Other to be my last Will and Testament

estate the best place well and reasonably with my beloved wife
the plantation set now two in with all its Benefits during her
natural life and widowhood and among the horses she may
think proper to choose out of my Stock and also three cows one
Red and of moderate such as she may suit her best During
her natural life or widowhood as aforesaid I will also give
unto my three sons that is to say Joseph Benjamin and John
Each of them to have the sum of five Dollars each I also will
and bequeath unto my wife one negro woman named Dina
at her own Disposal to do as she thinks proper with her
I will and bequeath unto my three Eldest Daughters that is to
say Ruth and Mary each of them to have fifteen Dollars each
