

It is remembered that I, Orinial Eames of Guilford County & State of North Carolina, Being of sane & perfect Mind do this 27th day of the 9th Month 1832 Make & Ordain this my Last Will & Testament that is to say. I will & direct that my Executors sell of such parts of my personal Estate as my family can but spare, an Amount sufficient to pay all my Just Debts & expenses incident to the settlement of my Estate.

I Will & bequeath to my beloved Wife Sarah, One Horse, Saddle & bridle, two Cows & Calves choice, four heads of Cattle, her feather Beds, Stairs & furniture, two Chests choice, One Table, four Chairs, to be at her disposal for ever.

I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Miriam One Bed, bedstead & all its furniture it having been in part made by her. One Cow & Calf 2nd choice.

I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Edith, One feather Bed & furniture, One Chest One Cow & Calf.

I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Mary Young all the property that we have given her heretofore and One Dollar.

I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Ruth Hixcock all the property that we have given her heretofore and One Dollar.

I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Nancy Bundy, all the property that we have given her heretofore and One Dollar.

And that all the residue of my Household & Kitchen furniture not disposed of in the foregoing items be left with my Wife Sarah during her Widowhood, and that at the expiration of her said Widowhood if any part thereof be left, that it be sold and divided in equal shares among all my Daughters.

I Will & bequeath to my Four sons, William, Joseph, Abraham & James, all the property that we have given them heretofore, and One Dollar each.

I Will & bequeath to my son Miles One horse the one he now claims.

And I further give to my beloved Wife Sarah all the residue of my personal Estate for her use during her Widowhood and at the expiration of her said Widowhood to be sold and divided in equal shares among all my Daughters.

I will & bequeath the tract of Land whereon I reside all the Land
in my possession to my Wife Jane during her widowhood
and at her death or Marriage it is my Will that the same
be sold by my Executor hereafter named, and that he make
as Debt to the purchaser, and that the same be sold on the
Credit of One and two years in equal instalments the purch-
aser giving sufficient security for the payment and that the
Money arising from the sale thereof be divided in equal shares
Among my Four sons before named
And Lastly I Nominate and Appoint Jacob. Hedgecock sole Executor
to this my Last Will & Testament, signed and sealed the day
& date just above written
