

I do remembred that I Ojibah Farmer of Beaufort County & State of North Carolina, Being of sound & perfect Mind do this 27th day of the 9th Month 1833 make & Ordaine this my Last Will & Testament that is to say. I will & direct that my Executor sell of such parts of my personal Estate as my family law but spare an amount sufficient to pay all my just Debts & expenses incident to the settlement of my Estate.

I will & bequeath to my beloved wife Anna, One Horse, saddle & bridle, two Cows & Calves choice, four pieces of Cloth, her feather Bed, Sheets & furniture, two Chairs choice, One Table, four Chairs, to be at her disposal forever.

I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Miriam One Bed, bedding & all its furniture it having been in part made by her self. One Cow & Calf 3rd choice.

I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Edith, One feather Bed & furniture, also that One Cow & Calf.

I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Mary Young all the property that we have given her hertofore and One Dollar.

I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Ruth Hodgecock all the property that we have given her hertofore and One Dollar.

I Will & bequeath to my Daughter Nancy Bundy all the property that we have given her hertofore and One Dollar.

And that all the residus of my Household & Kitchen furniture not disposed of in the foregoing items be left with my wife Anna during her Widowershood, and that at the expiration of her said Widowershood if any part thereof be left, that it be sold and divided in equal shares among all my Daughters.

I Will & bequeath to my Four sons, William, Joseph, Abraham & James all the property that we have given them hertofore, and One Dollar each.

I Will & bequeath to my son Miles One horse the one he may claims.

And I further give to my beloved wife Anna all the residus of my personal Estate for her use during her Widowershood and at the expiration of her said Widowershood to be sold and divided in equal shares among all my Daughters.

I will & bequeath the tract of Land wherein I reside all the Land
in my possession to my Wife during her widowhood
and at her death or marriage it is my Will that the same
be sold by my Executor hereafter named, and that the moneys
so paid to the purchaser, and that the same be sold on at
Credit of One and two years in equal instalments the Purchaser
giving sufficient security for the payment and that the
Money arising from the sale thereof be divided in equal shares
among my five sons before named.

And Lastly I Nominate and appoint Jacob Hodgecock Esq^r Executor
to this my Last Will & Testament, signed and sealed the day
