 a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors
 And as Touching my worldly Estate I bequeath & divide
 in the following manner To wit.
 1st I will & divide all my Estate Real & Personal to be equally
 divided among all my Children After all my Just debts
 are paid I allow my 30 Acre Tract of Land to be sold
 & as much of my personal property as will satisfy my debts
 & the Balance to be divided among all my Children
 I further Ordain constitute & appoint Joseph Gibson Esq.
 & George Christman to be my Lawfull Executors of this my
 Last Will & Testament - Signed Sealed & Acknowledged
 in the presence of This 26th day of June 1817.
