In the Name of God Amen. I George Coble of the County of
Guilford & State of North Carolina being in a low State of Health
but by the blessing of God, of sound mind & memory, And
Considering the uncertainty of life, & that it is appointed
unto all men Once to die. Do hereby make &
publish this my last Will & Testament in manner &
form following (Viz) My body I commit to the dust
from which it was taken, to be buried in a decent & Christian
like manner. & my soul to God who gave it.

And as to my Worldly Goods I dispose of them in the
manner following that is to say.

- 1st I Order & direct that all my Just Debts be forthwith fairly
paid off.
- 2nd I Will & bequeath to my beloved Sons, Philip, Paul, Jacob, Peter, Frederick
& Nicholas Coble certain lands Specified in Bonds created by me
to them Severally.
- 3rd I Will & bequeath to my beloved Daughter Mary Coble
the remainder of my Land, being One Hundred & Twenty five
Acres. together with one half of the use of my land
during her natural life, & at her Death, or failure of

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Issue it shall pass to, & belong to my two Sons or their Heirs Equally
that is my Sons Frederick & Nicholas Cobb.

4th I will & bequeath to my daughter Mary all my household &
Kitchen furniture, & One Mare all which or what remains of them
at her Death as aforesaid shall devolve to my Other Heirs Equally

5th I Order & direct that all my property, not heretofore mentioned
shall be sold at Public Sale, & the amount, together with
all money that I may die possessed of be Equally divided
amongst my children, or their Heirs, both Sons & Daughters.

6th And lastly I appoint & constitute my Son Philip Cobb
and William Forsbie to be the faithful Executors of
this my last Will & Testament.
