be buried in a decent and Christianlike manner —

first I give to my Son-in-law — Eliza Dovel and my daughter
Elizabeth wife of said Dovel all the money and property
which I have at this time it here have both in money
or other goods or property

Secondly I will unto my ^{beloved} wife Eliza Swiford all the Balance
of my Estate let it be Real or Personal whatsoever including
the right that I may or have to our black woman Kinder
moving to give all to my beloved wife during her life
for her benefit and support — And at her death my will
is that all that she may have in our hands shall go to
my Son Edmond it Swiford to have and his heirs for ever
lastly — I nominate my beloved wife my Executrix of
this my last will and testament

December 23rd 1829.
