

In the Name of God Amen I George Parsons of Guilford County State of North Carolina, being of sound & perfect mind & Memory. blessed be God, do this the twentieth day of January 1815 In the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred & fifteen make & publish this my last Will & Testament in the Manner following, that is to say.

First I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Rachel the black Man two Cows & Cows & One bed & furniture a plentiful maintenance of the plantation that we now live on her lifetime.

Secondly, I give & bequeath to my son James Parsons all my part of the Smiths lots.

Thirdly I give & bequeath to my son John Parsons one Cow & Cows & One bed & furniture.

Fourthly, I give & bequeath to my son William Parsons One son John Five Dollars.

Fifthly, I give to my son Enoch Parsons One hundred & fifty Acres of land where he now lives being a part of the tract of land I bought of Daniel Gibson.

Sixthly, I give to my son George Parsons that plantation where he now lives imputed at One hundred & Eleven Acres being part of a tract of land that I bought of John Harris.

Seventhly, I give to my son Robert Parsons One hundred & Eleven Acres of land on Richlands Creek, that I bought of Sebastian Parker, where, where my son Robert now lives.

Eighthly, I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Parsons the tract of land where I now live imputed, at One hundred & forty One Acres, & I give unto him my son Thomas Parsons all & singular my personal Estate, besides what is above mentioned in this my last Will & Testament by his paying unto my Daughters Mary Wilbourn & Catherine Parker each of them One hundred & Twenty five Dollars & by his paying all my just debts.

And I hereby make & Ordain my worthy sons George Parsons just & Thomas Parsons Executors of this my last Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I the said George Parsons have to this my last Will & Testament set my hand & seal the day & year above written.

Sippie of the County of Guignard & State of North Carolina being of sound Mind & Memory blessed be God, for his Mercy do Certify this my Last Will & Testament in Manner & form following (Wit) That I resign my soul to God who gave it & my body to the dust from whence it came & after paying all my just debts I give & bequeath to my beloved Daughter, Marchabal Foster one Dollar, I also give & bequeath to my second Daughter Catherine Dockery One Dollar, I also give & bequeath to my son Galat. Sippie One Dollar, I also give & bequeath to my Daughter Alarcha Alarchin One Dollar, I also give & bequeath to my Daughter Ann Alarchin One Dollar, all of which is to be raised out of my personal Estate.

I also give & bequeath to my beloved Wife Susanna Sippie all the remaining part of my personal estate, of every description what ever, with my Mansion house & Forty two Acres of land lying & being on the south side of the Town yard with all its conveniences appertaining thereto to have & to hold forever.

I also give for various good causes to my my Sundry and Forty Acres of land, adjoining to my Mansion tract beginning on the south west corner of said tract and running North to the same thence up the Creek North to a Maple thence East to a Stone in Evers Alights line, thence South to S. Alights line thence West to S. Alights line to a Stone at the Gate, from thence to the beginning.

I also appoint Samuel Holt's Executor to this my last Will & Testament signed sealed & delivered in the presence of this 30th day of the 5th Month 1832
