I Hans Corbie of the County of Guilford in the State of North Carolina being of sound mind & memory, & enjoying a tolerable state of health but considering the uncertainty of life & that it is appointed for all men once to die. Do Make Ordain & Publish the following as my last Will & Testament.

First My body I commit to the earth to be entred in a decent Christian like manner, my soul to the God who made it & as to my worldly goods I will that be disposed of in the following manner.

1st I wish all my Just Debts to be fairly & honestly paid after which I will & bequeath to my beloved Wife Anne the full use of the plantation on which we now live during her natural life or widowhood with such articles of household & kitchen furniture as she may deem necessary for own use.

2nd I will & bequeath to my beloved son W^m Corbie Two hundred Acres of Land embracing the home place under the aforesaid restrictions the whole of the balance of my moveable property Conditionally the use of the room to his sister Margaret & her bed two cows & better & their breed at her own disposal as she thinks fit;

3rd And lastly I appoint & constitute my beloved son W^m Corbie sole Executor to this my last will & Testament, in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this tenth day of July One Thousand Eight Hundred & Nine.
