Carolina, being weak in body but thanks God sound of Mind & Memory
do publish this my last Will & Testament, in Words following:-
First I want all my last Wills paid out of my estate.

Secondly I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Harrison One Negro
woman named Lucy to dispose of as she may think proper, I
give and bequeath to my Wife my Negro Man Esau, and a Negro
boy Elijah, and One Negro Girl Eliza, my Clock and Case, Cupboard
and furniture, One Desk, One Walnut Table, Two Beds & Bedding,
Furniture, One Wheel and Cart, two Hells, two Bows, One Whistle,
One Silver Mortar, Six Silver Churns, two Cows & Calves, two Horses,
One Deer and two Swine two Chickens, One Chicken House, one Stabling
Carriage & gear, One turning stone, One bull tongue or short plow,
Chains, hammers, backbands, knives and sundries. Twenty five Dollars
out of my Estate to buy a One horse plantation Wagon, I give her
the above property during her natural life or widowhood, I also
give her my house and plantation during her life or widowhood
what is not otherwise devised hereafter and then to return to my Estate.

3rd I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Rachel Five Dollars out of
my personal Estate and her proportional part of Lands.

4th I give and bequeath to my Daughter Lucy King and to the heirs of,
her body One Negro Girl Hannah and her proportional part of the Real &
personal estate when not otherwise devised.

5th I give and bequeath to my Daughter Abby Potter One Negro girl Micky
and Fifty Dollars out of my personal estate to make her equal her
proportional part of my Real and personal estate when not otherwise
devised of.

6th I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Hobbs One Negro girl
Charity and her proportional part of my estate both Real & personal
when not otherwise disposed of.

7th I give and bequeath to my Daughter Tabby Harrison One Negro boy
Samuel and fifty Dollars out of my personal estate to make her equal
and her proportional part of my Real and personal estate when not

Otherwise disposed of

8th I give and bequeath to my two Daughters Willy Egan and Polly Hanson one Negro woman Fanny her and her increase in equal divisions between my said two daughters if Polly should die without an heir it goes to Willy and her heirs at her death, and then proportional part of my real and personal estate if not otherwise disposed of

9th I give and bequeath to my Daughter Fanny Love one Negro girl Lilla and her proportional part of my estate both real & personal when not otherwise disposed of

10 I give and bequeath to my son John Hanson the sum of \$1000 out of my personal estate and his proportional part out of my real and personal estate when not otherwise disposed of

11 I give and bequeath to my son Henry Hanson my Negro boy George but he is to pay back to my Personal Estate out of the value of George One Thousand Dollars and then he is to have his proportional part of my estate both real and personal when not otherwise disposed of

I allow my Executor to let my remaining John Peter have forty rods of land in the west end of my land joining Peter's

I also allow my Executor to sell at Public Sale Court house to him Acre of land joining Louis Old River, in the same manner my tract and saw mill to be sold with five Acres of Land not to interfere with the Meadows I also allow my old mill tract and pond to be sold in the same manner

I constitute my Walter grand James Nelson to be my executor to this my last Will and Testament signed in the presence of this 20th day of February 1834

in the west end of my land joining Peter.

I also allow my Executor to cut at Public Sale Eight acres to have
Acres of Land joining Acres Old Mine, in the same manner
my first and last wills to be sold with ten Acres of Land
Not to interfere with the Meadows I also allow my old mill
race and pond to be sold in the same manner

I constitute my worthy friend James Nelson to be my executor to this
my last will and Testament signed in the presence of
this 20th day of February 1834
