 And State of North Carolina being in a low state of health but  
 in perfect mind & Memory Calling to mind that it is appointed for  
 all men to die do make And Ordain this my Last Will & Testam  
 as follows - 1<sup>st</sup> My will is that all my Just Debts shall be paid  
 2<sup>ndly</sup> My will is that immediately after my Decease that my Executor  
 (hereafter named) shall inventory all my Property & take in his possession  
 all of Said Property as is movable & as soon as it is convenient to  
 make Sale of all my property that I shall die possessor of  
 3<sup>rdly</sup> My will is that After my Just debts are all paid that all the  
 Money Left in the hands of my Executor shall belong to my dear Sister  
 Sundry Anthony to be paid to her by my Executor.  
 4<sup>thly</sup> My will is that all my Wearing Cloths be equally divided betwixt  
 my Two Brothers William Anthony & James Anthony  
 And I Constitute Appoint make & Ordain my dear friend Solomon  
 Warren to be the Executor of this my Last will & Testament & I do hereby  
 Enjoin on him my said Executor to dispose of my Estate as nam<sup>d</sup> above  
 And I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannul all and Every  
 Will by me heretofore made in Writings Other of I Henry Anthony have  
 here unto set my hand & Seal this 20<sup>th</sup> of May 1818
