I also ordain & appoint my son John Coff and Daniel Whitel to be my true & lawfull Executors of this my last will and Testament all and singular my lands, tenements and possessions by him freely to be possessed and enjoyed - and I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments, Wills, legacies, bequests and Executors by me in any ways before named, written and bequeathed. Ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament.
