In the first place it is my desire that all just claims against my estate together with personal expenses should be thoroughly and speedily discharged & secondly for the purpose of making an equitable division of my estate between all my children I hereby directing my executor to sell at public sale all my property both real and personal and equally divide the proceeds after defraying the necessary expenses attending the estate. And as my children showing to take in the amount in said division what each one has or may receive in my life time to be divided from their respective shares in a further division it is my desire that all the land now adjoining the Smith tract & lying west of the Hyattsville tract and hereafter to be conveyed and considered a part of the same my object is an equal division among all my children namely Christian, David
