 In the name of God amen I Henry Thompson being in perfect
 mind and memory and calling to my mind the mortality of my body I do
 commit my body to the ground to be decently buried and my soul to God who
 gave it and my estate and effects I bequath and dispose of in manner
 form following all my just and lawfull debts is to be paid and then
 I give and bequath to my beloved wife all my household goods and all
 my personal estate to hold in her own hands during her widowhood
 and if she should marry again the Executor shall take off two thirds
 of what there is to the use for the use of the children and hereby
 do leave my well beloved wife and my brother John Thompson who
 and soul Executors of this my last will and testament
