

In the Name of God Amen I Isaac Clapp of Eugene County & State of North Carolina, being Weak in body but sound in Mind & Memory do make & Ordain this my Last Will & Testament in the Manner & form as follows: Viz.

I have first & give & bequeath to my beloved Wife Lucy my plantation and all my property to do with it as she thinks best for her and my Children during widowhood or life and school the Children, and should my Wife Marry she shall have her bed, spinning wheel & set of house tools & look put & set of plates, 2 dishes & the balance to go as follows: The plantation rented & the negroes hired out and the other property sold & the Land & Black People to be equally divided when my youngest Child comes of age, or sold & the Money equally divided amongst all my Children.

Lastly I nominate & appoint Emanuel Clapp & Augustus Clapp Executors to this my Last Will & Testament. In Witness Whereof I haveunto set my hand & signed my seal this 20th day of September 1822
