2nd I leave my wife Elizabeth Mendenhall the plantation where I now live containing about one hundred and sixty acres and all my stock and farming utensils during her widowhood and at the expiration of her widowhood it is my will that the land stock and farming utensils which may then be left should be sold and equally divided between my sons Jacob and Miles Mendenhall and to their heirs.

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ruth Carter one dollar having already her what I intended her to have I give unto my son Isaac Mendenhall one dollar having previously given him what I intended for him.
