Thousand Eight Hundred & Twenty One that I Isaac Hunt of the County
of Guilford & State of North Carolina being weak in body but of
Sound mind & disposing memory do make & ordain this my last
Will & Testament, in manner & form following. (My witnesses, It is my
Will that my last debts & funeral charges be first paid & discharged
by my executors. hereinafter named out of my personal property.
First I Give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Merriam Hunt Two Feather Beds & furniture
my Gray mare & one side saddle One flax wheel One chest & all the household
furniture she had when I married her - One cow & calf for her
legacy of my estate 3 I Give & bequeath to my son William Hunt
Five Shillings for his legacy of my estate 3 I Give & bequeath unto my
son Joseph Hunt (being his first wife) five Shillings
for his legacy of my estate 3 I also Give & bequeath unto my son
Isaac Hunt One half of my Waggon for his legacy of my estate 3 I also
Give & bequeath unto my son Joel Hunt Five Shillings for his
legacy of my estate 3 I also Give & bequeath unto my son
Isaac Hunt five Shillings for his legacy of my estate 3
I also Give & bequeath unto my son Thomas Hunt All my
tract of land wherein I now live and the remaining half

of my Negroes all my farming tools all my wearing clothes & all the money
 I may have left after my debts are paid. & I give my Carriage to my
 wife Marianne ~~and my son Thomas~~ & son Thomas &
 my will is that my son Thomas shall give my daughter Marianne any
 Common Good Litter saddle & that my daughter Marianne shall have
 her & sufficient harness as is common for a woman to have
 in this County & that it shall be done at the expense of my Estate
 & Care of my Executors. It is my will that my wife Marianne
 shall have a comfortable support as long as she shall live my
 widow out of my Plantation & I also give & bequeath unto my
 daughter Marianne Hunt One Feather Bed & Common Furniture One
 Walnut Chest One Sore One Cotton Sheet One Quilt half
 a dozen Feather Sticks & One Case One Valance One smock
 One One Large Pot One Quilt Horse Three Chairs One Pan of
 Bed Sticks It is my will that if my daughter Marianne die without
 a Lawfull heir that my son Thomas Hunt should have her Legue
 in my Estate. Lastly I give to my son Thomas & my daughter Marianne
 the Remainder of my Estate to be equally divided between them -
 And lastly I do man. Give in Testimony & Attest in Court records
 Abel Knight Jnr & William Anthrunk Esq. Court Clerks to the above
 Last Will & Testament, Marry, Dickins & deannulling all Other Wills made
 by me hitherto. Inwitnessing this One Oath to be my Last Will & Testament.
