last Will & Testament in manner & form following first: Of Divine favour of all
I recommend my Soul to God who gave it & my body to be
buried in a decent Christian burial not troubling but I shall receive the
same by the Almighty Power of God - And as touching such worldly
estate which hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I Give &
devise in the following manner

1st I will & desire that all my Just Debts be paid
2nd I will & desire to my son George Cudwick all the Tract of Land
On which I live the Wm. & G. tract of 200 Acres as follows -
Beginning at a Station the South corner of the Tract containing 200⁰ & 67
52 Acs. to a Stake then 28⁰ W 120 poles to a White Gum Tree 20⁰
67 55 poles to a White Oak then 100⁰ W 160 poles to a black Jack then 20
55⁰ W 120 poles to a post Oak then 20⁰ W 275 poles to the beginning
containing 100 Acres - the boundaries of Cudwicks Part. are as follows beginning
at a Stake the 2nd corner mentioned in Georges containing 200⁰ & 67 52 poles to
a Cocking oak 27⁰ W 272 poles to a post Oak then 20⁰ W 60 poles to a
White Jack then 20⁰ W 100 poles to a White Oak then 20⁰ W 100 poles
to a White Gum. then 20⁰ W 120 poles to the beginning containing 100 Acres
I will and desire unto my beloved Wife Barbara One third of Six hundred
during her natural life

I Give & devise unto my Daughter Catherine One Hundred Dollars -
I Give the Key of my Store One Hundred Dollars -
I Give to my Daughters Deborah & Mary to each of them One Hundred Dollars.
It is my Will that all my personal property be sold & the money arising therefrom
with what shall be on hand that my beloved Wife Deborah have out of the same
One third part but all the monies & issues above mentioned was first to be
taken out or paid over & the balance then left is equally to be divided
between all my Daughters -
It is my Will that if any of my Children shall die without leaving issue or
Childen, that what I have given them shall return or its Value to be equally
divided among all my Children -

I will & desire unto all my Children to hold in Common a Negroes family
with the same to be divided among them

last Will & Testament in manner & form following first: Of Deane fully of all
I recommend my Soul to God who gave it & my body to the earth to be
buried in a decent christian burial not heathen but I shall receive the
same by the Almighty Power of God - And as Touching such Worldly
Estates which it has pleased God to bestow on me in this life I will &
doe in the following manner

1st I will & desire that all my Just Debts be paid
2nd I will & desire to my Sons George & Andrew all the Part of Land
On which I live the Remainder to George best of the Land are as follows
beginning at a Station the South corner of the Part containing 400⁰ & 67
32 Acres to a Stake then 28⁰ 10 120 poles to a White Gum then 45⁰
67 35 poles to a Stake Oak then 45⁰ 10 160 poles to a black Sack then 40
35⁰ 10 130 poles to a post Oak then 45⁰ 67 273 poles to the beginning
containing 100 Acres - the boundaries of Andrew's Part are as follows beginning
at a Stake the 2nd corner mentioned in George's conveyance to 45⁰ 67 160 poles to
a Stake then 47⁰ 10 270 poles to a post Oak then 45⁰ 67 160 poles to a
White Sack then 45⁰ 67 160 poles to a White Oak then 45⁰ 67 160 poles
to a White Gum then 45⁰ 67 160 poles to the beginning containing 160 Acres
I will and desire unto my beloved Wife Barbara One third of Six hundred
Sterling in Sterlings like

I will & desire unto my Daughter Sophia One hundred Dollars
I will & desire unto my Son Jacob One hundred Dollars
I will & desire unto my Daughters Deborah & Mary in each of them One hundred Dollars
It is my Will that all my personal property be sold & the Money arising therefrom
with what shall be on hand that my beloved Wife Deborah have out of the same
One hundred part but all the Monies & Securities above mentioned was first to be
taken out or paid over & the Residue then left is equally to be divided
between all my Daughters.

It is my Will that if any of my Children shall die without leaving issue or
Issue that what I have given them shall return or its Value to be equally
divided among all my Children -

I will & desire unto all my Children to hold in Common a Religious family
School by name according to Dutch Proverbiales "the young then got
Saves Well"

And I hereby constitute ordain and appoint my true & Trusty friends
Christiaan Claes & (Mr. J. Barnt) & Christianus Just Executors of this
