I do hereby in full view of my friends and in the presence of our Lord our thousand eight hundred & forty six make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner as follows, to wit:

- 1st My will and desire is that all my just debts be paid.
- 2nd I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Barbara, all of my household and kitchen furniture during her life time, also all the property and money that she receives from her father Michael Shallerly, and her mother Molly Shallerly's estate, including bedding, wearing clothes and every thing in my house of that kind.
- 3rd I give and bequeath unto my third youngest son, the tract of land whereon I now live to be equally divided between my third son George Noble & son Michael Noble upon condition that they maintain and take care of me and my wife Barbara, so long as we may live and then pay over three hundred dollars to the balance of my children, that is, six dollars to my son Abraham & the balance to my son John.

husband light hundred & forty six make and retain this my last will and testament in manner as follows, to wit:

1st My will and desire is that all my just debts be paid.

2nd I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Barbara, all of my household and kitchen furniture during her life time, also all the property and money that she receives from her father Michael Shaller, and her mother Molly Shaller's estate, including bedding, wearing clothes and every thing in my house of that kind.

3rd I give and bequeath unto my three youngest sons, the tract of land whereon Cobble & Michael Cobble are now situated that they maintain and take care of me and my wife Barbara, so long as we may live and then pay over their hundred dollars to the balance of my children, that is, ten dollars to my son Abraham Cobble, & six dollars to my son Abner Cobble, and the four daughters Margaret Porter, Sarah Marshall, Barbara Scott, & Molly Elliott. I also give unto my son George Cobble, Elias Cobble and my wife after her death it shall belong to them, also the Horse and grain

that may be on my premises at any time together with all the other property that I have already given them

1st My Will and desire is that the balance of my property not mentioned shall be sold and the money arising from the sale of said property to be equally divided among all of my children, Abraham bobb, Margaret Fatica Sarah Marshall Barbara Soots Helly Elliott & Anne bobb, George bobb Eliza bobb & Michael bobb, together with all other property that I have already given to each one of them.
