In the name of God amen. - I Jacob Heath of the County of Guilford and State of North Carolina have thought proper to make this to be my last will and testament in manner and form as follows -

First I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Heath all the moveable and immovable with any plantation whereon or unto it belonging during her natural life or widowhood and one of her father and mother I commit to her also

Secondly I give unto my eldest son Samuel Heath the land he now possesses

Thirdly - I give unto two sons Robert Heath and Ralph Heath the tract of land whereon they now live to be equally divided between them and to pay unto their

Two books Samuel Heath fifty dollars each one one of them I give unto my
dearest daughter Emily Pilkington three hundred dollars.

Secondly I give unto my daughter Keyia Heath three hundred dollars
and unto Rebekah Heath three hundred dollars to be given unto them at their mother's
decease or surivision or sooner if their mother pleases to do it and I allow that if my
estate should not be sufficient to afford them these hundred apiece they must put
up with less but every one of the three to receive an equal share but in case my
estate should amount to more to be equally divided between all my children both son
and daughter.

I do appoint for my Executors my wife Mary South and my son
Reuben South to be my Executors.
