James Cunningham.

In the name of God amen. September the 24th, 1791. - I James Cunningham of the County of Guilford and State of North Carolina being sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory - Thanks be given unto God - Therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men to dye do make and publish this my last Will and Testament - That is to say - Principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of God who gave it - And for my Body I recommend to the earth to be buried in Christian like and decent manner at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned - And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give and devise and dispose of the same in manner and form following:

Item - I give unto my two sons Jeremiah Cunningham, Matthew Cunningham whose I likewise make and constitute my only and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament, all my lands that I am possessed of, likewise a wagon and all my plantation tools and all horses that will not hereafter be mentioned to be possessed and enjoyed by them forever.

Item - I give unto my daughter Isabel Cunningham my young sorrel mare and saddle to be possessed and enjoyed by her forever.
