whome I likewise make and ordain constitute my only and sole Executors of this my last will and
Testament, all my lands that I am possessed of, likewise a wagon and all my plantation tools
and all horses that will not hereafter be mentioned to be possessed and enjoyed by them forever.

Item - I give unto my daughter Isabel Cunningham my young sorrel mare and sad-
dle to be possessed and enjoyed by her forever.

Item - I give unto my three children namely Jeremiah Cunningham, Matthew
Cunningham, Isabel Cunningham all my household furniture likewise all my cattle, hogs,
sheep and every other thing not mentioned above to be equal divided among the above named
three children to be possessed by them forever.

Item - I give unto my son William Cunningham
five shillings only of my estate. Item - I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Cunningham five
shillings only of my estate. I do hereby disavow, revoke and disannul all and every other former
Testament, will or Legacy bequeathed by me in any other way before this time named, willed
and bequeathed - ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament.
