I will give to my Wife Martha Peter & to her heirs forever he begins with the table
Secondly in the body of Rights One Dollar per acre for said plantation
And if the said George does not choose for to keep the said after the
aforesaid Grant then in that case I will it inherit to the aforesaid
Wife also all the Money Bonds Notes Books & Records & other Goods
which and have or shall have with all my household Furniture of every
kind I Give to my wife Martha Peter inherit at his death his heirs
as the aforesaid I also Request to my Sister Margaret Miller five
of Ten Dollars each amounting my Wife Martha & Matthew Young Executors &
Executors of this my Last Will & Testament I know & being this & to the
to be my Will In testimony I have hereunto set my hand hereunto set
