Land where I now live containing three hundred acres be equally
Divided Between my two Sons Elias Frazer & James Frazer lot taken
dying at a my Will that my beloved Wife Martha Frazer be at liberty
to Draw her Maintenance off all the above Described Land & money
and remain in full Possession of the Dwelling house unencumbered During
her remaining dayes & no longer than I also leave & Reguards
unto my beloved Wife Martha Frazer all my personal property
goods wares & Money & Bills after my just debts are paid for her use
use and Disposal Fully I constatale and affirme by my selfe that

I Will unto Matthew Young & his heirs forever he paying into the Table
decoy in the City of Raleigh One Collar w^t were for said plantation
and of which said Collar does not choose for to keep the same upon the
aforesaid tract then in that case I Will it entitle to the aforesaid
decoy also all the Money Bonds Notes Books & Accounts of our Debts
which and so doth be death with all my household Utensils of every
kind I give to my wife Martha to her self at her death his house
as the executors also Regard to my other daughter Mary the sum
of Ten Dollars also about my wife Martha & Matthew Young Executors
Executor of this my last Will & Testament I do hereby testify this 8th to Dec
to be my Will In testimony I have hereunto set my hand to set
My seal & affixed my seal this 8th day of December A.D. 1817.
