3rd I Constitute Stephen D. Rice and Joshua Highlowen my Executors to execute this my last Will & Testament

Whereupon it is Ordered by the Court that the same be admitted to records

Then Came into Court Stephen Rice one of the Executors appointed in said Will & qualified as such according to Law.
