Item 7<sup>th</sup> I give unto my son Samuel McClintonck the tract of Land I now live on.  
One hundred Acres with all the improvements thereon, I give said Samuel  
McClintonck One Iron Gray horse named Jack, a Saddle & bridle, One Cow &  
Calf, and One teacher bed of furniture & Thirty Dollars

To my Oldest Daughter Nancy Dillworth I give and bequeath One Bed & one Cow & furniture  
to the Amount of Forty Dollars inclusively.

To my eldest son Benjamin Dillworth I give and bequeath One Horse worth Forty Dollars.

To my son Lindsay Dillworth I give & bequeath One Horse worth Forty Dollars.

To my second daughter Nancy Dillworth I give & bequeath One bed, and one Cow & Furniture  
to the Amount of Forty Dollars inclusively.

To my third son George Dillworth I give and bequeath One Horse worth Forty Dollars.

To my third daughter Fanchy Dillworth I give and bequeath one bed and one Cow and  
Furniture to the Amount of Forty Dollars inclusively.
