mind & Memory do Make and Ordain this my Last Will & Testament in Manner
here following First etc I give my soul to God who gave it me & my body to the
Church from whence it came to be buried in a Christian decent Manner at the
direction of my Executors and as to my worldly substance I leave in the follow-
ing Manner viz.

1st I will that my Just debts be paid out of my Estate by my Executors.

2nd I will that my Executors after my decease to sell as much of my personal
Estate as will pay my Just debts and all Expenses.

3rd I will that my beloved Wife Abigail Phiffer have all my Real & personal Estate
during her life or widowhood and after her death as hereinafter as follows.

4 I will that after my Wife's death that my Executors Proceed to sell the pher-
-talions and all the property left by my Widow & divide as follows—

5 I will that my beloved Daughter Rachel Phiffer Rec^{ve} Ten Dollars of my Estate

6 I will & bequeath to my Daughter Sally Phiffer Ten Dollars.

7 I will & bequeath to my Daughter Ann Mooney Ten Dollars.

8 I will & bequeath to my Grandson Edward P. Gamble Five Dollars.

9 I will & bequeath to my son Benjamin Phiffer One Dollar.

10 I will & bequeath to my son in law Conrad Richardson One Dollar to his Children

And after the above named sums is paid the balance to be divided as follows

Equally between my sons Joseph Phiffer & Jeremiah Argey & Abigail Pritchard

Rachel Phiffer & Ann Mooney Sally Phiffer & Peggy Richard & James Phiffer.

Finally I do hereby revoke all the Wills & parts of Wills I do. establish this to

be my Last Will & Testament as it is written & Further I do hereby nominate

& appoint my trusty friends Daniel Gladson & James Phiffer Junr as my Ex-
-ecutors to this my Last Will & Testament. In Testimony whereof I James Phiffer

have set my hand & affixed my Seal this 14th day of October A.D. 1829.
