Item I give & bequeath unto my well beloved Wife Priscilla Buson the plantation whereon I now live also the use profit & income of all my personal Estate while she remains my widow in Order bring up & Educate the Children, but in Case she should Marry Again my will is she shall have the use of One Third Only.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my Son Jchu A Buson the Tract whereon I now live at the death or marriage of my Widow.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my Three Sons Jesse, Joel & Hester W Buson my bullock Tract of Land Also a piece of meadow ground Joining Tho^s Sanders to be Equally divided between them.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my Two Daughters Jane & Lucretia Buson when they shall become of Age Four Hundred Dollars a piece to be made of my personal Estate. - I also will unto my wife Priscilla my black Woman Moriah during her widowhood live.

And Lastly I Constitute and appoint & make my beloved Wife Priscilla Buson Executrix & Thomas Sanders Executor Jointly of this my last will & Testament - In Witness whereof I have to these presents set my hand & Seal this 27th day of April in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred & Twenty.
